It quickly became clear that "Zeus" - as the animal lover called him - would soon become a Berliner and all the necessary preparations for the EU pet passport were initiated.

The animal lover spared no expense or effort and took "Zeus" home a few days ago. Now he is on his way to sneaking into the hearts of the two other four-legged roommates.
